



Texas Chapter Distinguished Service to Public Works Award

Purpose	To recognize an elected or appointed government service leader for far-reaching impact on local, state, or national public works programs, services, or policies through exemplary public service and commitment. This award particularly recognizes leadership in furthering the mission and goals of public works.
Eligibility	Nonmembers of APWA who are recognized leaders and have made a positive impact or significant contributions to the public works field. Candidates may be any elected or appointed official from local, state, or federal government.
Selection	<p>The Awards Committee reviews the nominations and selects the award winners.</p> <p>Applications should address the following specific criteria, which will be evaluated in the selection process:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Identify significant contributions to the public works field—provide specific information about the nominee’s involvement and services provided to further the mission and goals of public works.• Describe the nominee’s positive impact—provide specific information related to the nominee’s actions that created a positive impact on public works.
Nomination Process	Must be nominated by any member of APWA. Submissions are limited to 10 pages. The page limit does not include a letter of introduction from the nominator.
Presentation	The award winner is recognized at the awards ceremony during the Texas Chapter Annual Public Works Conference.
National Award	Winner will also be automatically submitted by the Chapter for the APWA Distinguished Service to Public Works Award.
