

Texas Chapter Exceptional Performance Award

Purpose

This award recognizes individuals, teams, or organizations in the areas of adversity, journalism, and safety whose outstanding contributions in the course of performance raises the level of public awareness of the profession.

Adversity Recognizes exceptional performance in the face of adversity in service to the public.

Journalism Recognizes exceptional performance in presenting the story of a public works issue or event that projects a positive image of individuals or agencies in the course of their performance in both broadcast and print mediums. All nominated publications must have been originally printed within the past two years.

Safety Recognizes exceptional performance in the area of safety.

Eligibility Candidates may be an individual, team, or group of individuals or organizations meeting the purpose of the award. APWA membership is not required.

Selection The Awards Committee reviews the nominations and selects the award winner.

Nomination Process Nominations may be made by a Branch, individual APWA members or nonmembers. Submittals must include nomination

form and documentation supporting the purpose of the award and the award's eligibility requirements. Submittal for

the Exceptional Performance Award – Journalism must include the actual article/publication/transcripts.

Presentation The award winner is recognized at the awards ceremony during the Texas Chapter Annual Public Works Conference.

National Award There is not a national award in this category.
