

Texas Chapter Richard Ridings Community Involvement Award

Purpose	To recognize public works employees who are also leaders in their community. The award also encourages public works professionals employed by governmental agencies to become active leaders in their community. It also promotes public trust in public employees through recognition of outstanding community leadership.
Eligibility	 Candidates must meet all the following criteria: Be an active member of Texas Chapter and be employed by a public agency at the local, regional, state, or national level. Is an active leader in the community demonstrated through the volunteering of significant time and/or personal resources with charitable organizations or community service groups. Provide a positive role model for other public works professionals employed by public agencies.
Selection	The Awards Committee reviews the nominations and selects the award winner.
Nomination Process Nominations may be made by a Branch, individual APWA members, community organization, or public agency. Submittal should include nomination form and supporting documentation.	
Presentation	The award winner is recognized at the awards ceremony during the Texas Annual Public Works Conference.
National Award	As of 2023, APWA sunset the national award in this category.
